

**Camp Y.I. is a CLOSED TOE shoe environment. No sandals with open toes at main camp, or at any of our programming areas.**

With our terrain in mind, we suggest tennis or hiking shoes or boots that may get wet and dirty. For horseback riding we suggest a shoe with a slight heel, or riding boots. For lake activities we suggest water shoes or slip-on sneakers. Sandals and flip-flops are allowed for shower use only. Slip & Fall hazard, we do not allow Crocs on camp. Numbers mentioned are general guidelines, feel free to adjust for your personal situation.
