The following medications are stocked in the camp infirmary and may be administered for a variety of minor complaints by campers according to the health care center guidelines. Please read over this list of medications.

CIRCLE ANY MEDICATION LISTED THAT WOULD **NOT** BE ACCEPTABLE FOR YOUR CHILD TO RECEIVE WHILE AT CAMP.

Acetaminophen (Tylenol)	Ibuprofen (Advil or Motrin)
Aleve (Naproxen)	Excedrine (acetaminophen, aspirin, caffeine)
Diphenhydramine (Benadryl)	Antacid tablets (Tums, Rolaids)
Antibiotic Ointment	Claritin (Loratidine)/ Zyrtec (Cetirizine)
Calamine Lotion	Guafenisine (Mucinex)
Calydryl	Midol
RID (or similar for lice)	Maalox/Maalox Plus (or similar)
Milk of Magnesia	Immodium
Robitussin or Robitussin DM (or similar)	Chloraseptic Spray or Lozenges (or similar)
0.5% or 1% Hydrocortisone Cream	Swimmer's Ear Drops
Ipecac stocked for accidental poisoning	Ben Gay (or similar Analgesic)
Visine Eye Drops	Pepto-Bismol
Blistex Cream (for Cold Sores)	Tinaction (Tolnaftate)
