**Health Form** (5 pages)-this form was part of your online registration process. **Be sure to sign the "permission to treat" located at the bottom of page 1.** If your child requires treatment, we will notify you immediately.

- Medication will be administered as prescribed by the Camp Nurse.
   Prescription medications should be in their original container. All medications, including over the counter medications must be labeled with camper's name and instructions.
- Please dress your camper in comfortable, light colored, breathable clothing to prevent overheating.
- Tennis shoes are best Sandals if desired, but they must have a back strap.
   No crocs or flip flops please
- Water bottle-REQUIRED-we provide water coolers at all activities for campers to refill water bottles throughout the day
- Sunscreen-REQUIRED-it is recommended that you provide the sunscreen best suited for your camper's needs
- Swim Suit & towel-Day campers will swim daily
- Bring long pants-Wednesday only- for horseback riding. Hard sole shoes are required to ride horses. (Tennis shoes are fine)
- A white t-shirt for tie-dye at Arts & Crafts activity-not required Snack of your camper's choice that does not require refrigeration. Your camper will have access to their back pack often throughout the day.

## **Youth Incorporated Policies:**

- Alcohol drugs and weapons; Youth Incorporated maintains a zero tolerance for; possession and/or use of alcohol, illegal drugs and/or weapons (including knives), abuse and/or harassment of campers or staff. If a camper violates any of the above policies, the parents will be notified and the camper will be required to leave Camp Y.I. premises.
- Vehicles and Animals; Campers are not allowed to bring vehicles nor animals to Camp. Campers are not allowed to operate vehicles while at camp nor be a passenger in any vehicle other than for emergency purposes.
- Personal Property Policy: Campers are not allowed to bring personal sports equipment other than the following: Lifejacket-must be PFD approved, horseback riding helmet. We provide Foursquare and Basketballs for use during camp.
- Visitation policy: One of the most important aspects of the camp experience is practicing independence skills. Although this can be challenging for parents, we ask you to respect our no visitation policy. If you would like to check on your camper, please feel free to call the Camp Office 615- 459-3971. For the safety of all campers and animals, please do not drive into main camp unless you have an appointment to do so.

## **Directions**

Please note that some GPS instruct you to turn left onto OLD JONES MILL RD. This is incorrect! Once you turn onto Jones Mill Rd from Fergus, travel 4.3 miles to the END OF THE ROAD, 1/4 mile PAST Poole Knobs Campground Area. The last 1/4 mile is ONE lane-please drive slowly.

**From Nashville**: I-24 East, Exit 64, Waldron Rd/LaVergne. Turn right and travel 2 1/2 miles to Murfreesboro Rd., turn right onto Murfreesboro Rd. and travel 2 1/2 miles to traffic light @ Fergus Rd. (just past Walmart) turn left and travel 8/10(.8) of a mile to Jones Mill Rd., turn right and follow 4.3 miles to the end of the road past Poole Knobs Campground. (

**From Murfreesboro**: I-24 West to Sam Ridley Pkwy, Smyrna, Exit 66, there is only one exit coming from this direction. Travel 2 1/2 miles to the LaVergne/Smyrna Exit (exit ramp is immediately after you cross over Murfreesboro Rd/ HWY 41). If you pass the Smyrna Airport you have gone too far. At Murfreesboro Rd (HWY 41) yield right toward LaVergne, travel 1.5 miles to the traffic light at Fergus Rd. (Exxon Station on the corner) turn right, travel 8/10 (.8)of a mile to Jones Mill Rd., turn right and follow 4.3 miles to the end of the road past Poole Knobs Campground.
